



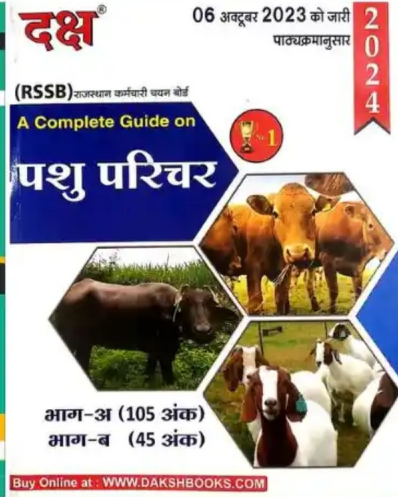

Rajasthan Pashu Paricharak Books 2024 - Exam Pattern

The Rajasthan Subordinate and Ministerial Services Selection Board (RSMSSB) Animal Attendant Exam 2024 will have an objective-type question paper with multiple-choice questions (MCQs).
